Cleveland paid a Polish immigrant \$150 to serve in his place in the American Civil War.
Cleveland was the only president to serve two non-consecutive terms.
S I G N I F I C A N T A C T S Signed the Interstate Commerce Act of 1887, which established federal regulation of railroads. Preserved the country's gold standard in 1893 by spearheading the repeal of the Sherman Silver Purchase Act of 1890. Crushed the Pullman railroad strike of 1894 and prevented interruption of mail service by sending in federal troops. Prompted the settlement of the Venezuela crisis, a border dispute between British Guiana and Venezuela resolved in 1895.
C A R E E R 1871-1873 Served as sheriff of Erie County, New York.
1882 Served as mayor of Buffalo, New York.
1883-1885 Served as governor of New York.
1885-1889 President of the United States.
1888 Defeated by Benjamin Harrison in presidential election.
1893-1897 President of the United States.
As sheriff in Buffalo, New York, Cleveland personally carried out the execution of two criminals. Cleveland underwent a secret operation aboard a yacht to remove his cancerous upper jaw in 1893.

Notes for Rev. Eurotas Parmele Hastings:

"For forty-three years Dr. Hastings was a laborious and successful missionary of the American Board in the Island of Ceylon. He was connected with the Batticotta Seminary for seven or eight years, the latter part of the time as its principal. Jaffna College was established in 1871, as the outgrowth of Christian schools, to satisfy the pressing demand for higher education in Ceylon, and it fell to Dr. Hastings, as its first president, to organize a course of advanced studies in science, languages, and literature; and the work was wisely accomplished.

"In the history of evangelized Ceylon, Dr. Hastings will be always honored as an impressive preacher, with social gifts that commended his pulpit utterances; as a competent, earnest, patient, unselfish teacher who won the hearts of his pupils; as a thoughtful, far-seeing organizer, who laid right foundations broadly and deeply; as an attractive example of what is best in religious and scholarly culture."
