At the age of 15, Fillmore was apprenticed to a cloth maker.

S I G N I F I C A N T A C T S Signed a series of bills known as the Compromise of 1850, which included the Fugitive Slave Law providing for the return of escaped slaves to the South. Sent Commodore Matthew C. Perry on a mission to open Japanese ports to U.S. trade.

C A R E E R 1833-1835 and 1837-1843 Represented New York in the U.S. House of Representatives. 1846 Became the first chancellor of the University of Buffalo. 1849-1850 Vice president of the United States under Zachary Taylor. 1850-1853 President of the United States. 1856 Ran an unsuccessful campaign for president with the Know-Nothing (American) Party.

Fillmore's wife, Abigail, set up the first White House library.

Fillmore declined an honorary degree from Oxford University, stating that "no man should . . . accept a degree he cannot read."
