He was born in the town of Leray Sept. 26, 1885, his parents being Lewis Isaac a and Ida Getman Walrath. His great grandparents came up from the Mohawk valley i in the very early days of the 19th century and located upon lands in LeRay but a few rods distance from those of the famed Indian hunter and scout, Robert Si Sixbery.. The Walrath homestead is on the Evans Mills-Chaufuys Corners county road , just a short distance from the site of the old Crystal Spring cheese factory . Several of the farms in that section were owned by the Walrath family. His Mother other was from the pioneer stock of the Herkimer section, her people locating i in Orleans upon coming north.

Mr. Walrath married Alta Hosmer (sic) at Watertown on Dec. 21, 1910 and ten year later he located in this village. He was greatly interested in producing hone y and was a member of the Jefferson County and the Empire State Bee Keepers asso ciation. He usually kept from one to two hundred colonies.

He was a member of the local lodge of Masons and of the local fire department an d of the Pamela Grange. He attended the Presbyterian church in this village.

He is survived by his widow, three daughters, Mrs. Niles L. Horton of Chaumont , Katherine Barbara and Ella Marie Walrath of this village; one sister, Mrs. Per on Kiechle of Philadelphia; one niece, Esther Kiechle and four nephews, Carl, Pa ul, Roy and Benjamin Kiechle of Philadelphia.

According to a letter written 2-3-1993 by Ida Mae Horton, Alta's daughter, Alta' s father left for Montana in 1910 and he left Alta with his sister, Dolly Smith . Alta was then eight years old and stayed with Aunt Doll until she was old eno ugh to go out to work. She used to mention those who she worked for, said Ida M ay, but she could only remember a Gibson Clyde and Vanderwalkers, but there wer e more, she said. "You know, my grandfather worked farms in the LaFargeville ar ea at some time. Outside of LaFargeville I can show you where Mom and Aunt Pear l were born, and also the stone school house where Mom went to school. I don' t know where all these events come together in their history."

Ida Mae also said: "Must be the red hair was on the Hasner side, because my Mo m had red hair when she was young, so she always told me. My father had jet bla ck hair."

"Mom attended Boon St. school. I well remember Aunt Mary and Milan (sic) Eddy , who lived on Hyde Lake not far from Theresa." (another quote from Ida Mae's l etter)
